Beginning January 2023, there was a 4.5% rate increase for Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Louisiana plans and a 5.94% rate increase for the Vantage Medical Home HMO plan. Because LSPRS deducts for insurance a month in advance, many members did see a small reduction in net payments. BCBS mailed members a new insurance card on December 17, 2022 that detailed CVS Caremark as the new pharmacy benefit manager for the BCBS health plans (Pelican HRA and Magnolia Plans). If

you have not received a new insurance card, visit the BCBSLA website to print off a copy of a card or call BCBS at 800-392-4089. Lastly, Office of Group Benefits has stated that annual enrollment meetings will be held in-person for all members this year.
